Notes from Ken

I saw this on the internet recently as I was preparing for Pentecost Sunday. I share this with you as a reminder of the power of the Holy Spirit to work in us and to transform us for God's good intent.

PENTECOST!

Praise – We are caught up in the Spirit and our lives exude praise and thanksgiving to God for the gift of life in Christ.

Empower – As believers we're empowered to get out into the streets and witness to God's good news with people of every nation and tongue. The Spirit is not a passive presence.

New – At that first Pentecost the disciples were doing something new and wonderful; the folks that heard them were invited into a new understanding of life and a new relationship filled with grace and hope.

Truth Telling – They shared the truth of God's amazing love and vision for the human family and the reconciling work of Christ for the world and our relationships.

Enthusiastic – Enthusiasm is derived from 2 Greek words: en = in and theos = God. The Spirit encompasses us within the heart of God and breathes into us the joy and dance of life.

Communal – The Spirit unites us with others; our experience is so rich we can't keep it to ourselves. We must share the Good News.

Overt – When you are filled with the Spirit, it finds expression and activates us into celebrating God's presence visibly with one another and the world.

Spontaneous – We live under the Spirit's direction. We deflate the Spirit by over-analyzing and rationalizing our own hesitations.

Trusting – We are called to trust in the Spirit, relying on its direction and God's faithful promise to hold us and be with us as we venture in faith to share grace and love, hope and peace.

I hope you will feel the power of the Holy Spirit and that you will let it be reflected in your life.
